### **~New~ Moments of Light - Thoughts on Self-Isolating**

Let me recommend three steps for overcoming loneliness, First RECEIVING Jesus, second ENJOYING Him and thirdly SHARING Him. They have worked for me, and they might work for you too.

- **Receiving Jesus**

The Bible contains the following words in John chapter 1 and verse 12 ... "He came to his own, but his own did not receive him. But to all who did receive him, he gave the right to become children of God." How then do I receive him? First realise that Jesus is alive and not dead, having been crucified, but then raised from the dead, and declaring himself to be "alive for evermore", and capable of entering the hearts of anyone - yes, anyone - who invites him in - even you and even me. Tell him that you want to receive him and invite him in. Record it in writing for all to see.

- **Enjoying Jesus**

Thank him for having come. Be in no doubt that, however feebly uttered your invitation may have been, HE CAME. Take plenty of time to lie back and thank him for being there, in your heart. Or, to put it another way, to be in the driving seat of the vehicle called "you", in my case called my "Stittsmobile", with him in the driver's seat and me on the back seat allowing him to make all the decision about where to go, at what speed, and where to stop, without me interfering with any attempted "back seat driving".

- **Sharing Jesus**

Find just one other person with whom to share your new discovery of having received Jesus into your heart. If you cannot think of anybody, talk to Belinda, who has a list of those who would be only too happy to contact you either by telephone, Zoom, with the sole object of praising him together and thanking him for having taken each of you over as part of his family.
