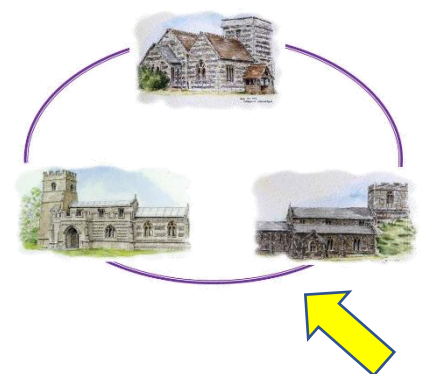

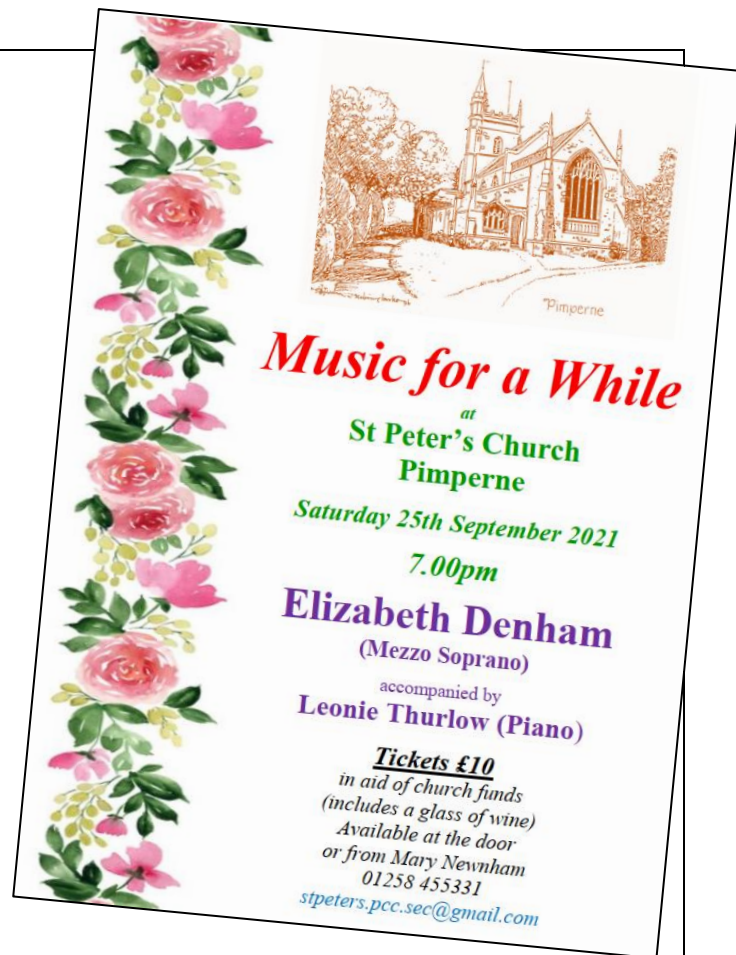

All Saints Church, Tarrant Monkton is taking clothes for men women and children but NOT men's shorts.

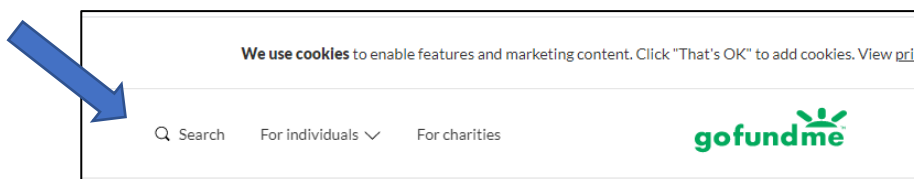
- Bedding-and towels but NOT duvets or pillows

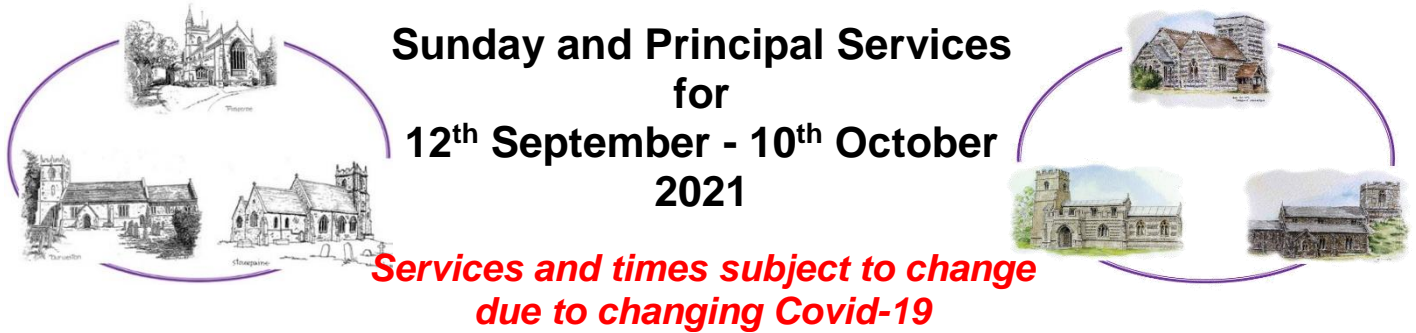
