First Reading

Hebrews 1.5-end

⁵ For to which of the angels did God ever say,
'You are my Son;
today I have begotten you'?

Or again,

'I will be his Father,
and he will be my Son'?

⁶ And again, when he brings the firstborn into the world, he says,
'Let all God's angels worship him.'

⁷ Of the angels he says,
'He makes his angels winds,
and his servants flames of fire.'

⁸ But of the Son he says,
'Your throne, O God, is for ever and ever,
and the righteous sceptre is the sceptre of your kingdom.

⁹ You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness;
therefore God, your God, has anointed you
with the oil of gladness beyond your companions.'

¹⁰ And,

'In the beginning, Lord, you founded the earth,
and the heavens are the work of your hands;

¹¹ they will perish, but you remain;
they will all wear out like clothing;

¹² like a cloak you will roll them up,
and like clothing they will be changed.

Israelite in whom there is no deceit!' ⁴⁸ Nathanael asked him, 'Where did you come to
know me?' Jesus answered, 'I saw you under the fig tree before Philip called
you.' ⁴⁹ Nathanael replied, 'Rabbi, you are the Son of God! You are the King of
Israel!' ⁵⁰ Jesus answered, 'Do you believe because I told you that I saw you under
the fig tree? You will see greater things than these.' ⁵¹ And he said to him, 'Very truly,

Harvest festival at St Nicolas Durweston will be at 11am on Sunday 7th October.

Check you are eligible for Pension Credit:

The Winter Fuel Payment is an annual payment to help you with heating costs during the colder months. The Government announced in July 2024 that, from this year onwards, to be eligible you must have reached State Pension age and also receive a qualifying means-tested benefit e.g. pension credit, universal credit or income support.

The last possible date to make a successful backdated claim to receive the Winter Fuel Payment is 21 December. Applications for Pension Credit can be made on the [How to Claim](#) page on GOV.UK or over the phone by calling 0800 99 1234 (Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm).



Over State Pension age?

You could be entitled to **Pension Credit** and get the **Winter Fuel Payment**.*

Check your eligibility for Pension Credit online.
