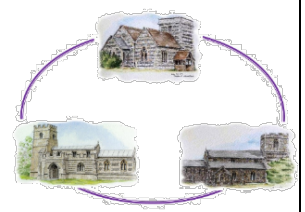

## Readings for 14<sup>th</sup> September 2025

### First Reading

#### Philippians 2.6-11

<sup>6</sup> who, though he was in the form of God,  
did not regard equality with God  
as something to be exploited,  
<sup>7</sup> but emptied himself,  
taking the form of a slave,  
being born in human likeness.  
And being found in human form,  
<sup>8</sup> he humbled himself  
and became obedient to the point of death—  
even death on a cross.  
<sup>9</sup> Therefore God also highly exalted him  
and gave him the name  
that is above every name,  
<sup>10</sup> so that at the name of Jesus  
every knee should bend,  
in heaven and on earth and under the earth,  
<sup>11</sup> and every tongue should confess  
that Jesus Christ is Lord,  
to the glory of God the Father.

### Gospel

#### John 3.13-17

<sup>13</sup>No one has ascended into heaven except the one who descended from heaven,  
the Son of Man. <sup>14</sup>And just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must  
the Son of Man be lifted up, <sup>15</sup>that whoever believes in him may have eternal life.  
<sup>16</sup> 'For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who  
believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life.  
  
<sup>17</sup> 'Indeed, God did not send the Son into the world to condemn the world, but in  
order that the world might be saved through him.
