Ride and Stride - Supporting the Historic Churches of Dorset including ours -12th September 2020

An annual fixture in every parish is the Ride & Stride event to raise funds for the Dorset Historic Churches Trust. Its aim is to help to keep our beautiful Dorset churches maintained by giving grants for repairs eg. to roofs, prevent water leakages etc.

Fran Rough and Matt Towill took part in Ride and Stride on behalf of Durweston and Pimperne Churches. They visited 12 churches during the course of the morning most of which were in the Tarrant Valley. If you would like to sponsor them there is still plenty of time to do so. Half of the money raised will be given back to the two churches.

If you are thinking of attending a Church service, please could you consider the following:

- Hymn books, Bibles and service orders have been stored away. If you are attending the BCP service, please could you bring a copy of the Prayer Book with you. For other services there will be a take-away service sheet for you to keep.
- Social distancing in church remains at two metres. This means we may need to restrict the number of people attending the service.
- No groups may exceed 6 unless from the same household.
- You will be asked to wait at the door; the church warden or sides person will direct you to your seat.
- The wearing of face coverings is mandatory when attending Church Services.
- At the end of the service, please remain seated until you are asked to leave by the church warden or sides person.
- The toilets at St Peter's and St Nicholas' churches will be open for use.
- Please do not gather in the Church Yards after Services.
- There will be a retiring collection at the end of the service. Please place your gift in the basket as you leave. However, there is high level risk of cross contamination associated with coins and notes. If this is your usual way of giving, could you perhaps now consider paying by standing order? COVID-19 Track and Trace Government Requirements

From Thursday 24th September all venues, including Churches must display a QR Code for Track and Trace purposes that can be scanned by individuals on entering the Church using the COVID-19 App on their Smart Phone.

If one doesn't have a Smart Phone, then the normal paper based collection of Phone Number will continue.

We want to start a 'conversation' between the school children and the church. They are very interested in how things were for you when you were their age. It can be short or long. Entirely up to you.

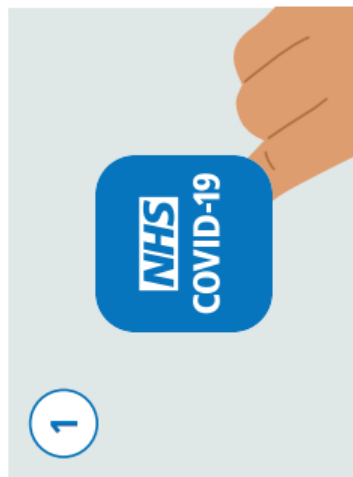

How to use QR codes to check into a venue

User guide



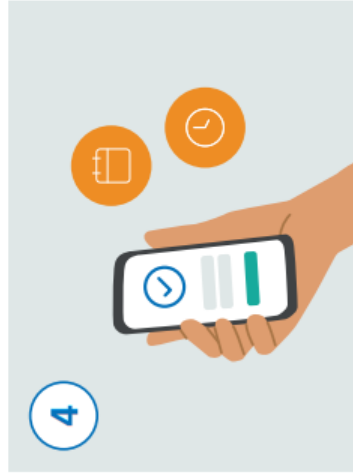
Download the NHS COVID-19 app from the App Store or Google Play Store.



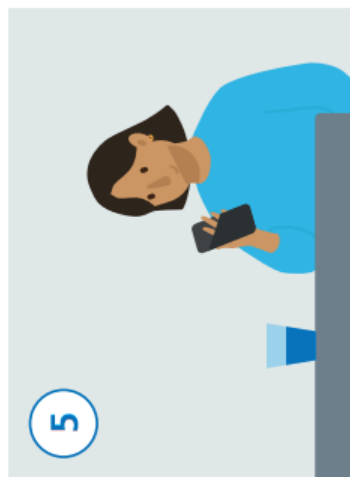
When you visit a venue, check to see if there is a NHS COVID-19 app QR poster on display.



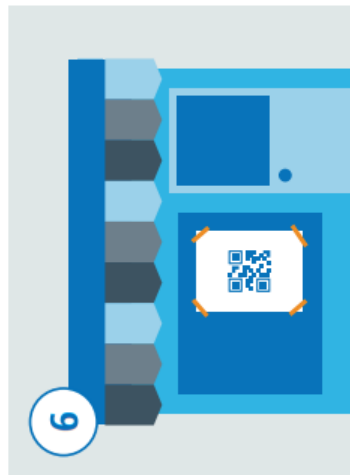
Open your NHS COVID-19 app and tap "Venue Check In". Now use your smartphone camera to scan the QR code on the poster.



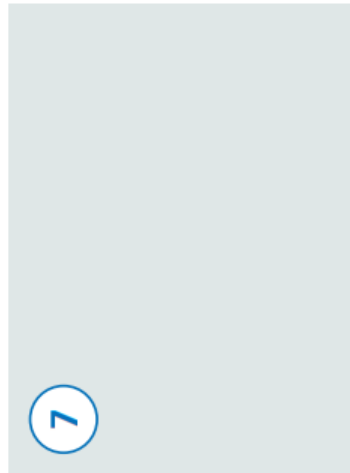
The time and date of your visit will be stored on the app. It will not be sent or shared with anyone else.



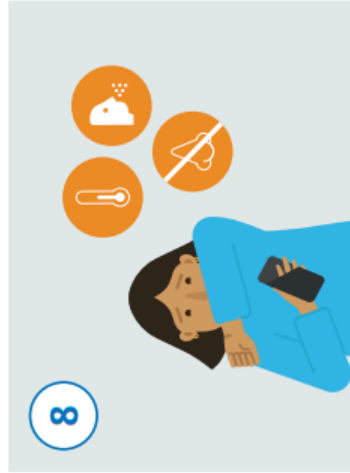
After scanning your QR code on the poster, you are now successfully checked in.



If you go to another venue, open your NHS COVID-19 app and tap "Venue Check In". Now use your smartphone camera to scan their QR poster.



You may get an alert if NHS contact tracers identify that you have recently visited a venue where you may have come into contact with coronavirus (COVID-19). If you are under 18, you are advised to show this alert to a trusted adult.



If you develop coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms, make sure to record them in the NHS COVID-19 app and follow Government guidelines/advice.
