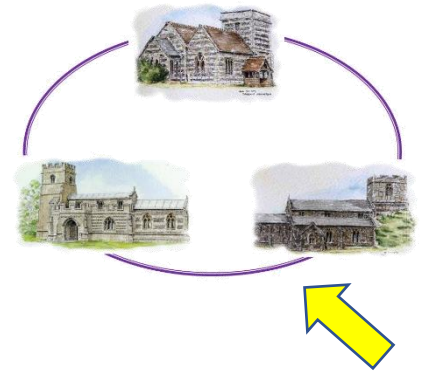
The following Zoom Services will continue in July at their present times:

STREAMING OUR SERVICES – FEASIBILITY – HELP NEEDED!



- Can you install an app on your mobile phone?
- Do you know how to check that your mobile data is switched on?

If you answered 'yes' to both of those questions, please read on

....your 'Comms' team (Belinda, Martin, Judy and myself) would like to check out the feasibility of streaming church services using mobile data, primarily for the benefit of members of our congregations who find it difficult to get to church. Belinda has done a successful test service with her phone, so we know it can be done. In the end, we envisage a single dedicated phone (not yours!) that can be taken to any church to enable streaming.

But first of all, we need to know which networks (eg Vodafone, o2, Virgin, Sky, TalkTalk, GiffGaff, etc, etc) work best from inside all 6 of our church buildings. I'm putting together a quick test that you can do on your phone when you are in church, which will help us enormously in making the right decision.

NOTICES

~ **Reminder** - If you are thinking of attending a Church service, please could you consider the following:

- Bibles and service orders have been stored away. For non BCP services there will be a take-away service sheet for you to keep.
- Social distancing in church remains at two metres. **This means we may need to restrict the number of people attending the service.**
- You will be asked to wait at the door; the church warden or sides person will direct you to your seat.
- The wearing of face coverings is mandatory when attending Church Services.
- At the end of the service, please remain seated until you are asked to leave by the church warden or sides person.
- The toilets at St Peter's and St Nicholas' churches will be open for use.
- **Collection plate!** Our churches may be closed, but they still need to be maintained and insured so that they will be ready for worship when the doors do finally open. Many of you normally support the church by putting money into the collection plate. If you have been saving your money up, could you

perhaps now consider paying by standing order? If you would like more information on this method of payment, please contact your church treasurer:

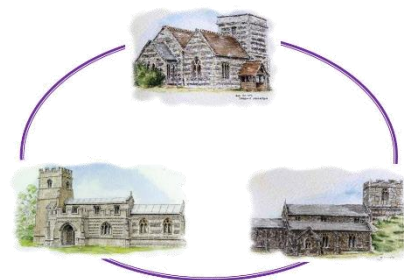
