### **Thought for the week** (Mark 6: 1-13 Ezekiel 2: 1-5)

Do you know that piece of music from the 1986 film *The Mission*, known as Gabriel's Oboe? It is a beautiful and haunting melody played over smooth strings, and was written by Ennio Morricone. It is first heard near the beginning of the film, when Father Gabriel – a Jesuit priest and missionary – enters the jungle to preach to the Guaraní community. Previously, the Guaraní tribe has been violently hostile to outsiders, but Gabriel decides to go alone and play his oboe, hoping that the music will reach them, touch them.

Gabriel makes the difficult journey through jungle and across rivers and up mountains to find the Guaraní territory. When he catches sight of some tribesmen, he begins to play. The Guaraní creep close, drawn in by the magical sound. However, one tribe member becomes angry and grabs the oboe and breaks it in half. Another gestures for Gabriel to carry on playing. Gabriel gestures back, trying to say that he cannot play it because it is broken. The tribesman examines the oboe, then beckons Gabriel to follow him to the village, where he repairs it.

This is the true start of the mission, when Gabriel is in need and the Guaraní people can – and do – help him. It takes a lot longer for the Guaraní people to trust and accept him; and longer still before they are open to his gospel message. But this is where it began. It is like the moment that the disciples entered a village asking for hospitality, making themselves vulnerable and trusting in God's grace and getting alongside people and getting to know them, because once you are trusted and respected, people may want to hear what you have to say.

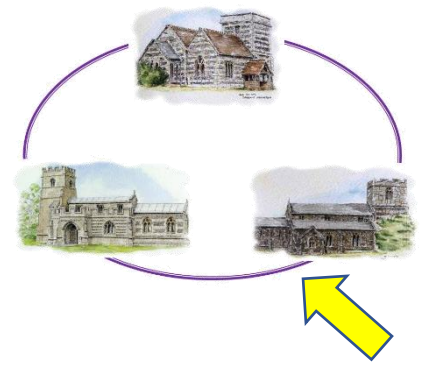

~ **Reminder** - If you are thinking of attending a Church service, please could you consider the following:

- Bibles and service orders have been stored away. For non BCP services there will be a take-away service sheet for you to keep.
- Social distancing in church remains at two metres. **This means we may need to restrict the number of people attending the service.**
- You will be asked to wait at the door; the church warden or sides person will direct you to your seat.
- The wearing of face coverings is mandatory when attending Church Services.
- At the end of the service, please remain seated until you are asked to leave by the church warden or sides person.
- The toilets at St Peter's and St Nicholas' churches will be open for use.
- **Collection plate!** Our churches may be closed, but they still need to be maintained and insured so that they will be ready for worship when the doors do finally open. Many of you normally support the church by putting money into the collection plate. If you have been saving your money up, could you perhaps now consider paying by standing order? 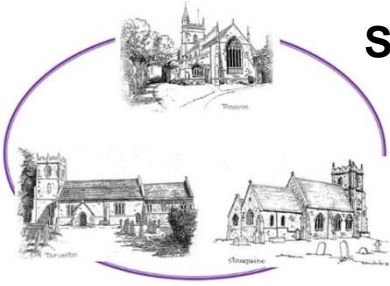

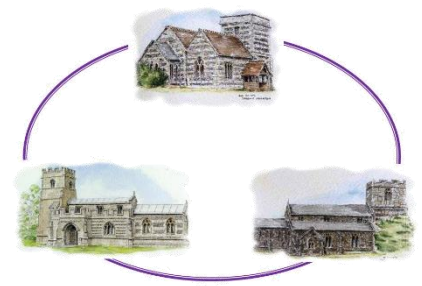
