~ ~ COVID RESTRICTIONS UPDATE ~ ~

The Rev Belinda Marlitt has met with the ministry team and church wardens to discuss and agree the way forward in the light of the advice being given and 'extreme caution' being recommended. It has been decided that we will continue to adhere to the following restrictions which will be reviewed in 4-6 week's time.

- Social distancing in church will remain at two metres, using alternative pews.
- The wearing of face coverings is requested when attending Church Services, unless exempt.
- Singing is allowed with masks on while inside, singing outside will continue where possible and weather permitting.
- If you have a smart phone you are still requested to log in to the Church using the QR code.
- Please continue to use hand gel on entry and exit.
- Please continue to use the one-way systems where they exist.

- Durweston & Tarrant Hinton will possibly be OK
- Tarrant Gunville & Tarrant Monkton will sadly probably not be OK

O2 and Vodafone came out on top with their signal strength and upload speed, so we now intend to carry out some short test 'broadcasts' using each network. For these tests **we will need some VOLUNTEER VIEWERS**. I have one enthusiastic volunteer already, but will need a few more. It will involve sitting in front of your computer for something less than 10 minutes, and letting us know the result. Would you like to help? **If so, I'd be delighted if you could let me know!**

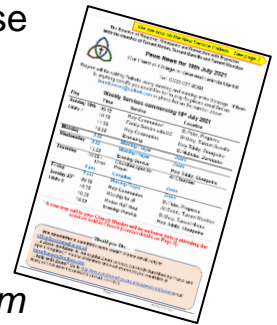
